ABOUT THIS ASSESSMENT

The Health-First Urban AI Maturity Assessment provides a structured method for evaluating how effectively a city perceives urban conditions, transforms information into intelligence and applies that intelligence through transparent, coordinated and human-directed governance.

Rather than measuring technological sophistication alone, the assessment evaluates whether Urban AI strengthens the institutional capabilities required to improve the conditions for long-term human flourishing.

How effectively the city transforms awareness into understanding and foresight.



INTERFACE — Human Governance & Coordination

How effectively people and institutions govern and apply Urban AI.



HUMAN FLOURISHING

The extent to which Urban AI strengthens the conditions for long-term human flourishing.
